

All music lessons will be charged at the rate sent out by the Visiting Instrumental Teacher, who will bill parents directly at these rates. It is the intention that an annual average of 30 lessons will be the norm. Any special arrangements, e.g. to coach for examinations, will be cleared with parents in advance.

There is no separate charge made by the School for ensemble playing.
